## HS2 Learning Legacy

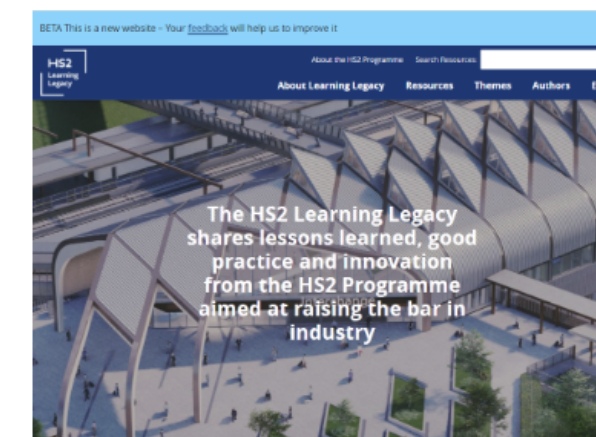
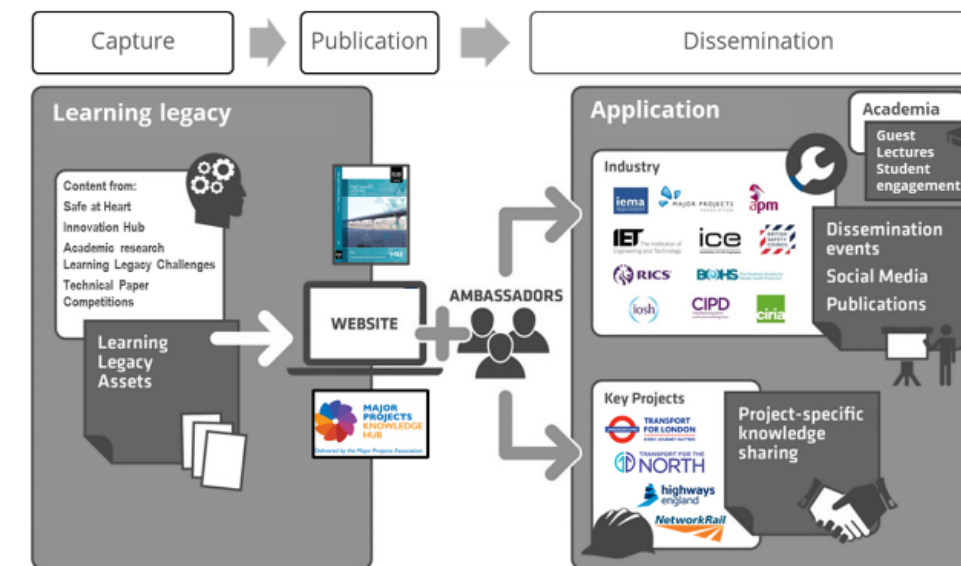
The HS2 Learning Legacy builds on the learning legacies produced by previous major projects including London 2012, Crossrail and Thameslink London Bridge. Its purpose at HS2 is to capture lessons learned, good practice and innovation from the HS2 Programme aimed at raising the bar in industry, improving UK productivity and showcasing UK PLC internationally. The scope of the project was to develop the a Learning Legacy Framework and implementation plan for approval by the Exec, roll it out into the business, the supply chain and industry, and handover to a permanent team.

## Services Provided

- Content generation: capture of content from across HS2 and its supply chain
- Organisation: developing supporting tools to publication governance, review, edit and approval
- Publication: delivery of a website, technical books for print and journal publications with industry partners
- Dissemination: establishing partnerships with industry bodies to host dissemination events.
- A soft launch of HS2's Learning Legacy was delivered in Nov 2020 with a public launch by the HS2 Minister in Oct 2021.

## Added Value

- A new Learning Legacy website including 100 learning legacy resources sharing good practice innovation and learning from across HS2 and the supply chain with industry.
- Two hardback books containing 49 technical papers published with the Institution of Civil Engineers.
- Participation by more than 250 authors across 28 organisations
- A framework has been established to enable an ongoing structured approach to capturing and sharing learning with industry.
